Digital Inclusion Workshop

Dan introduced Stacey Vincent, a Digital Inclusion Fellow being hosted by the Utah Nonprofit Housing Corporation in Salt Lake City, UT. Discussion followed regarding a possible workshop to be held in February or March focused on digital inclusion. Stacy defined digital inclusion as access to devices/ technology, access to the internet, and the skills necessary to use digital technology and digital content. Stacy is one of three digital inclusion fellows in Utah. After the meeting, a digital inclusion workshop was scheduled for Friday, February 3, 2017 at the West Jordan Library from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Stacy and her colleagues will organize and present the workshop. The workshop will tentatively include an overview of digital inclusion, resources for libraries, using volunteers and community partners, and device lending. RASRT will be sponsoring and promoting the workshop and providing food for the attendees.

Discussion of Possible Webinars

Members discussed possible topics for webinars to be presented through the Utah State Library. Adrea noted that the program on social media done by Leslie Schow and Liz Sollis at the ULA Fall Workshop was excellent and could be a good webinar topic. Leslie and Liz are interested in presenting a webinar on this topic. After the meeting, Dan contacted Jessica Whetman at the State Library about scheduling a webinar in March. The members agreed that a webinar on jail librarianship by Vern Waters would be another good topic. Dan will contact Vern to see if we can schedule a webinar in January. Ideas were also discussed for possible webinars to be done after the next ULA conference. Nia is interested in a train the trainer webinar, possibly with Sean Bailey of Salt Lake County. Other topics mentioned were internet filtering laws and self-publishing.

RASRT Social

This topic will be discussed more fully at the next meeting. The basic idea is to host a social event on the pre-conference night of the 2017 ULA Conference, which will be May 17 in Sandy. Various ideas were discussed previously including bowling, miniature golf, meeting at a local restaurant, and music and food at the West Jordan Library or the Whitmore Library.

Dan will send out possible dates for a meeting in December or early January, probably at the West Jordan Library.
